



Tires

Tires are banned from Ohio landfills because they hold methane gas and undermine the integrity of the landfill. They are a public health nuisance because they hold stagnant water that can breed disease-carrying mosquitoes.

Until tires can be disposed, make sure they are free of water, cover and store them.

Tires with or without rims are accepted at special DKMM (Delaware, Knox, Marion, Morrow) Solid Waste District Household Hazardous Waste and Tire Drop Off events. There is a fee based on the size of the tire.

When purchasing new tires, let the tire store take care of the tires you are replacing. The Delaware County Solid Waste Transfer Station accepts tires for a fee. The transfer station is located at 888 US Rt 42 North, Delaware 43015 or call for details at 740-369-7700.
