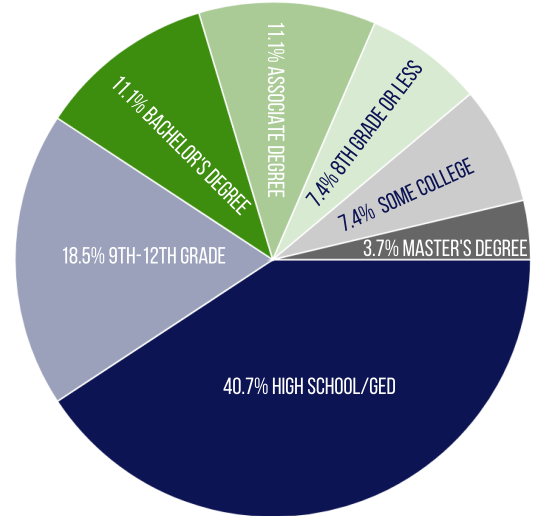


OVERDOSE DEATH DATA



- Total Deaths due to OD in 2017: 27
- 44% Females, 56% Males
- Ages range from 21-60 (Mean = 39.9 - Median= 43)
- 92.6% White, 7.4% Black
- Died in Delaware County: 66.7%
- Married: 11.1% - Divorced: 37% - Single (Never Married): 51.9%

COMPARED TO OVERALL EDUCATION LEVEL OF GENERAL POPULATION

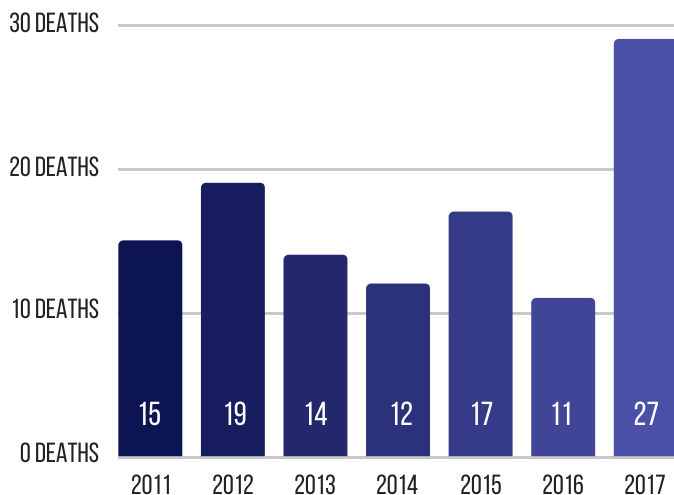
96.6% PERSONS AGE 25 YEARS + HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE OR HIGHER

52.5% PERSONS AGE 25 YEARS + BACHELOR'S DEGREE OR HIGHER

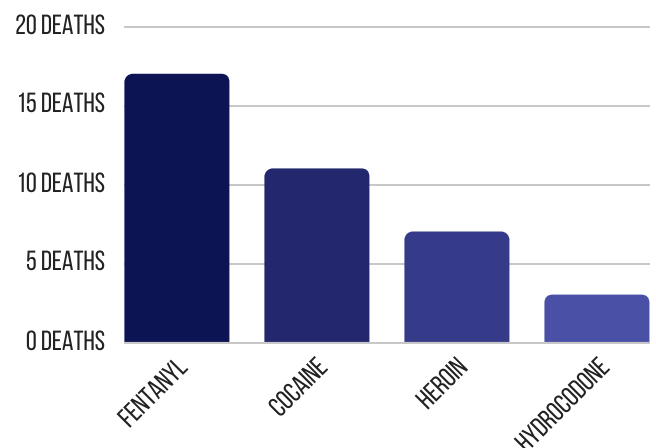

DEATHS DUE TO DRUG OVERDOSE



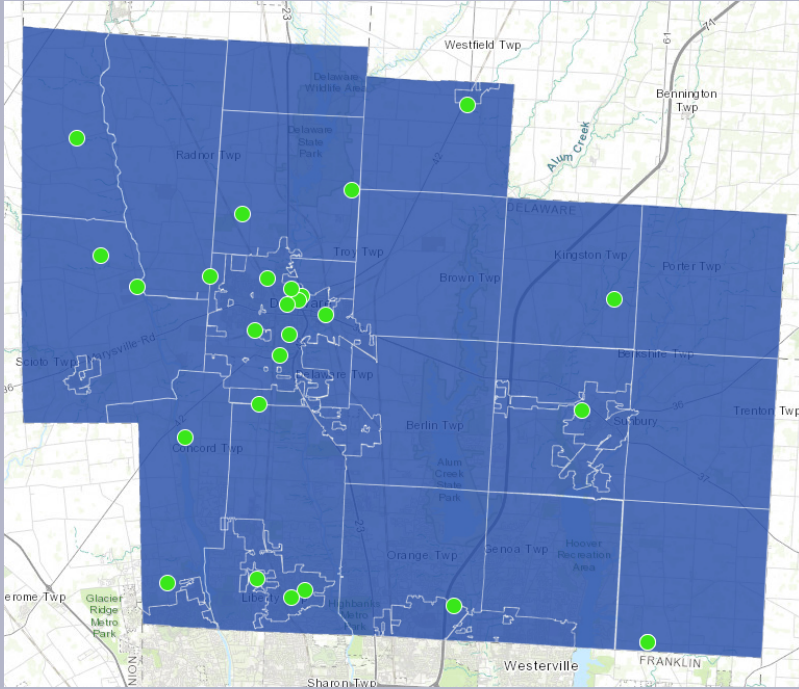
SUBSTANCES FOUND MOST FREQUENTLY IN THOSE THAT DIED OF A DRUG OVERDOSE



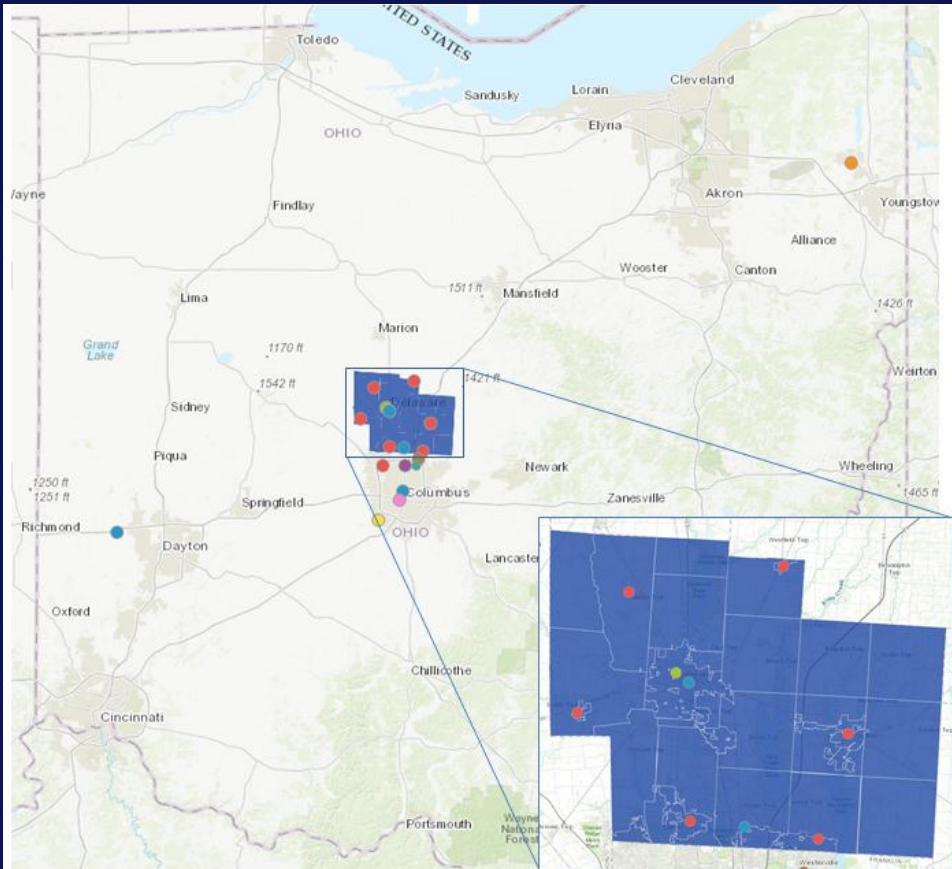
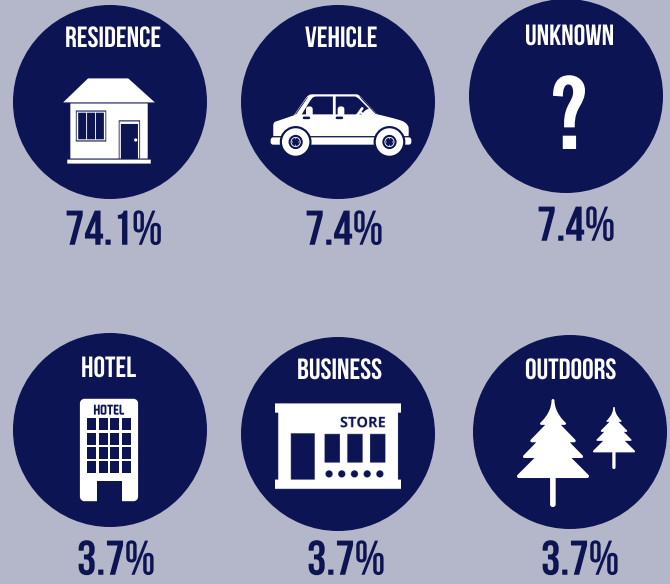


DRUG OVERDOSE DEATHS BY RESIDENCE
