Dear Manufacturing, Distribution & Construction Operator:

We have received and continue to receive many questions regarding the Director's Stay Safe Order (May 1, 2020) and how it may relate to manufacturing, distribution and construction.

*Section 2 of the Director's Order **Businesses and operations to reopen.** "All businesses and operations in the State, except as defined below, are permitted to reopen within the State as long as all workplace safety standards are met."*

Below are some important areas to reference regarding the Stay Safe Ohio Order (May 1, 2020). Please read the Stay Safe Ohio Order to ensure you are able to comply with all applicable sections.

Section #8 of the Director's Order contains the requirements regarding Facial Coverings.

- Businesses must require all employees to wear facial coverings except for one of the following reasons,
- Facial coverings are not required when they are prohibited by law or regulation, when they are a violation of industry standards, when they are a violation of safety policies, or the employee works alone in an assigned work area. The business should have written justification if a job task does not require mask.

Section #20 of the Director's Order contains General COVID-19 Information.

- Employees stay home until they are fever free (without medication), symptom free and at least 7 days since symptoms began for 72 hours.
- Frequently perform enhanced environmental cleaning of commonly touched surfaces.

Section #21b of the Director's Order contains Sector Specific Information.

- Ensure 6 feet spacing between people or install barriers.
- Employees must perform daily symptom checks.
- Consider having distributors and guests wear face coverings at all times.
- Stagger entry between employees and guests.
- Daily deep disinfection of high-contact surfaces
- Ensure 6 feet spacing between customers.
- Immediately isolate and seek medical care for any individual who develops symptoms at work.
