Birth Certificates — available for anyone born in Ohio by walk-in, phone or mail order. Fees apply.

Car Seat Safety Checks — safety checks for all residents. Free car seats to those who qualify. Call (740) 203-2079 to request an inspection.

Clinical Services — adult & child immunizations and health screenings, including back-to-school, flu, COVID-19, travel vaccines and more.

Community Coalitions — consider joining one of our coalitions that focus on a variety of health issues such as tobacco prevention, chronic disease prevention, healthcare, traffic safety and litter prevention.

Communicable Disease — investigation, education and response to disease outbreaks.

Community Health Assessment and Improvement — continually assessing the health of the community, identifying health risks, and determining evidence-based strategies to improve the health of the community.

Community Profiles — learn about your specific community, including stats on health and population.

Foodborne Illness Complaint — report a foodborne illness through the complaint form located at DelawareHealth.org/food-safety.

Food & Pool Inspections — food and pool inspection reports available at DelawareHealth.org/food-safety.

Litter and Recycling — your resource for recycling drop-off locations, curbside recycling options and special collection events (electronics, tires, paint, hazardous waste, paper shredding).

Mosquito Control — disease testing in mosquitoes, fogging for disease prevention and free treatment of standing water.

Naloxone Program — free Naloxone kits available to residents in an effort to reverse an opioid overdose. For more info, visit DelawareHealth.org/naloxone.

Nuisances — for environmental complaints call (740) 203-2070 for investigation.

Prenatal and Newborn Home Visiting — free and available to any expecting mothers & newborns. Free Pack 'n Plays available for qualifying families.

Rabies Prevention — investigation of animal bites and scratches.

Sewage Treatment Systems (STS) — individual sewage systems must operate properly and are being phased into an operation and maintenance program.

Water Sampling — sampling available for wells, cisterns, springs or ponds. Fees apply.

WIC — supplemental food program for eligible pregnant, post-partum and nursing women, as well as children ages newborn - 5 years.
