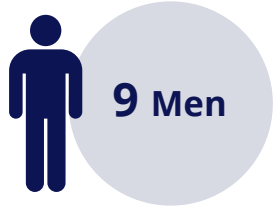

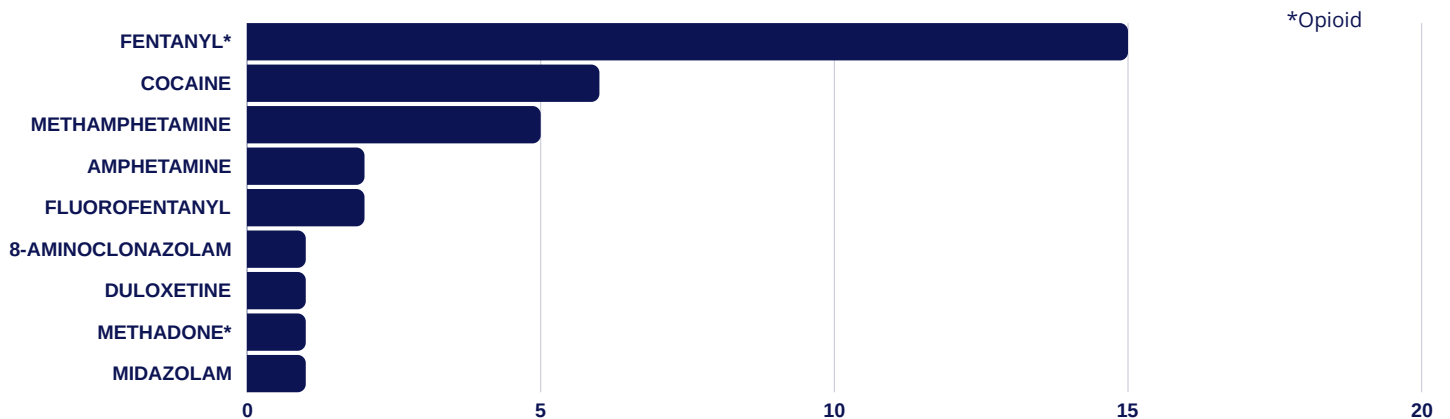

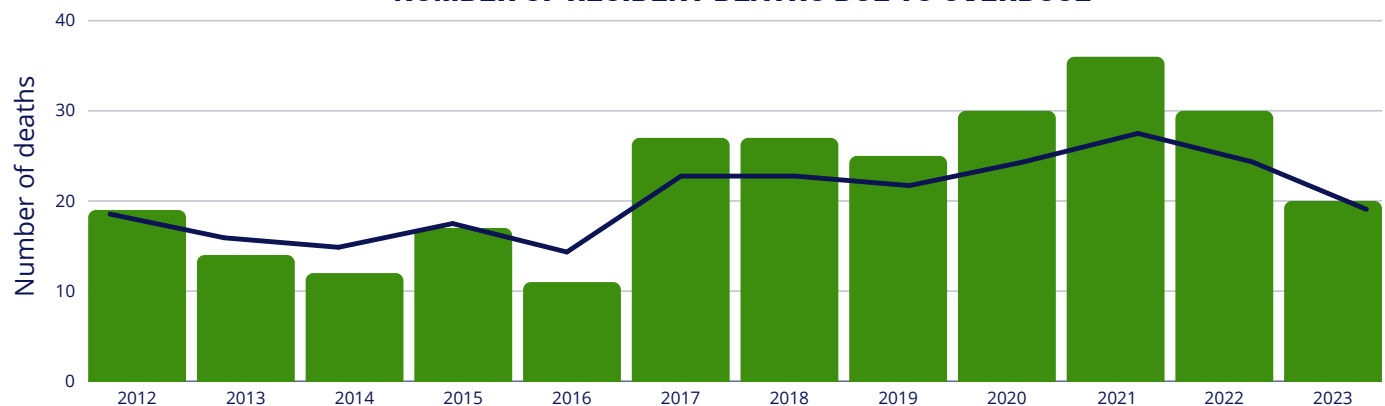

## DELAWARE COUNTY EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT VISITS FOR SUSPECTED DRUG OVERDOSE

- The group with the highest amount of ER visits with suspected overdoses were individuals **15-34 years old**.
- **40%** of ER visits were individuals aged 15-34 years old.
- There was a total of **318 ER visits** of Delaware County individuals for suspected drug overdose.

## HEALTH DISTRICT PROJECT DAWN | 2023

- Distributed **661** individual Project DAWN kits.
- Trained **348** individuals in Project DAWN opioid education and Naloxone distribution.
- Distributed **99** First Responders kits to Law Enforcement and security personnel.
- Provided Naloxone in **256** first-aid kits, AED kits, and Naloxboxes.
- There were **29** overdose reversals by first responders in 2023.\*

\*This data was collected from Delaware County law enforcement offices. It does not include any overdose reversals that may have occurred from interventions outside of law enforcement.
